FAQs

How many students played with BSYO last year? About 100 per year

What instruments are included in the BSYO program?

BSYO string students play violins, violas, cellos, and bass. The symphony level includes instruments in the woodwind, brass and percussion families.

What level do you have to be to be a member of the BSYO?

Student placement is determined through auditions held at the beginning of each season. Audition criteria for each ensemble is available to all interested students in advance.

How many conductors do you have?

Currently we have 4 conductors – one for String Ensemble, one for Festivo and 2 for Symphony Orchestra (strings, brass, winds, percussion).

When do you practice?

Monday evening rehearsals.

What is the cost?

The cost is \$350 per student for the season.

Auditions will be held in August with rehearsals weekly Monday nights through May.






How is my donation used by BSYO?
